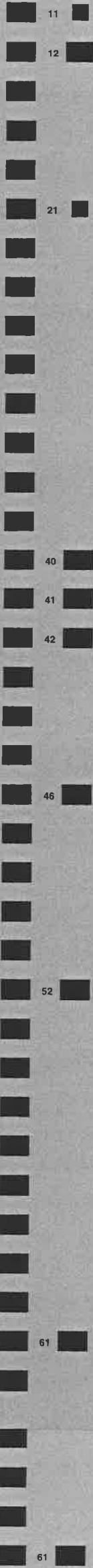

County Commission of Brooke County, WV ADDITIONAL LEVY 911 COMMUNICATION CENTER (Date of Election-May 12, 2020)

An election to authorize an additional levy for a term of four-years in which the fiscal years shall beginning July 1, 2021, July 1, 2022, July 1, 2023 and July 1, 2024, and for the purpose of providing \$570,296 annually, which includes an allowance for delinquent taxes and tax discounts, in additional levies, which levies will be used by the County Commission of Brooke County, West Virginia, to specific county current purposes and expenses, including providing sufficient income for the operation of the Brooke County 911 Communication Center. Funds will be used to operate, maintain, improve and repair equipment; train and educate employees; purchase supplies needed for the general maintenance and repair of the 911 Communication Center facilities; provide for salaries, wages and benefits of the employees; and for capital improvements to the 911 Communication Center, entered according to the Order of the Brooke County Commission entered on the 4th day of February 2020.

If for any reason all of the operating expenses of the foregoing agencies be fulfilled and there remain monies generated by the excess levy, said extra funds may be expended by the Brooke County Commission for capital improvements, to fund mandated offices or for any lawful purpose at the discretion of the County Commission.

If the tax revenues received by the Brooke County Commission do not generate sufficient sums of money to fund the allocations for the entity identified herein as set forth, the County Commission shall then not be obligated to expend money from the general funds of the Brooke County Commission to fund such allocations.

That the additional rate of levy in cents per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation on each class of property shall be:

Class I	1.60 cents
Class II	3.20 cents
Class III * if any	6.40 cents
Class IV	6.40 cents

The approximate amount for the purpose, after making due amounts for delinquencies and exonerations for the Brooke County 911 Communication Center is \$570,296 annually and that the amount shall be for a term of four years beginning July 1, 2021, July 1, 2022, July 1, 2023 and July 1, 2024.
