

REGULAR ADJOURNED SESSION OF THE COUNTY COMMISSION OF BROOKE COUNTY,  
WEST VIRGINIA, HELD TUESDAY, OCTOBER 16, 2018

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The County Commission of Brooke County, West Virginia met in regular adjourned session this 16th day of October, 2018 at 10:30 a.m. at the Courthouse.

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The Commission held their preliminaries before the meeting including a prayer and pledge of allegiance.

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A motion was made by Jim Andreozzi, seconded by Stacey Wise and unanimously passed to approve the minutes of the meeting held on October 9, 2018.

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A copy of the following correspondence was given to each of the Commissioner's for their review:

A letter was received from Jo Barki, Prosecutor outlining his previous conversation for the hiring of John Kyle as a full time Assistant Prosecuting Attorney.

An e-mail was received from the Secretary of State's Office explaining that someone is making calls to residents asking them to register to voter over the phone. This is a scam - we do not register to vote over the phone.

A letter was received from the State Tax Department letting us know that the Valuation Fund Budget that was submitted for FY2018-19 carry-over needs to be adjusted to reflect the correct balance, which was not \$32,000 but \$50,395.

The above correspondence was ordered filed in the County Clerk's Office.

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Butch Rotellini was present and let the Commission know that he had discussion with the bank that holds the lien on the dilapidated property at 113 Police Lodge Road, Colliers. He is working with the Commission to see if the bank may be responsible for the property condition since they hold the lien. He also met with the property owner on Washington Pike (Painter Run) and the owner has made a little progress on cleaning up the debris.

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Reverend Knight was present and expressed concerns about the urgency for the radio system used by the Sheriff Department for emergencies. He is concerned for the safety of those that respond to these emergency calls and feels it should be a priority for our officers. Commissioner Andreozzi stated that he respected his comments and is willing to meet with him after the meeting to discuss the progress that has been made. Reverend Knight is the minister for the Sheriff Deputies.
