**Unfinished Business** – Chairman Bachinski brought up the issue of Dilapidated Building complaint forms that had been filed and months had passed without any response from the county. Commissioner Ennis said that the committee had not met in a while, but was resuming its activity in March. He will ask them to take a closer look at these issues.

It was also suggested that issues that were concerned with rubbish accumulated around properties could be sent directly to the sheriff for investigation.

Commissioners Ennis and Wise suggested that we have press coverage of our work on the ordinance detailing how it will benefit future development in Brooke County.
